

**Arizona Department of Water Resources Arizona Spatial Reference Center Real
Time Global Navigation Satellite System Message User's Responsibility and
Agreement for the Use and Access of Data**

GENERAL

The real-time data broadcasts, in Radio Technical Commission for Maritime Services ("RTCM") format, for the stations which are a part of the Arizona Spatial Reference Center ("ASRC") system is offered to you, the user ("User"), as a public service. The ASRC is an activity of the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR"). Read the following to understand the limitations regarding the information provided and the use to be made of these RTCM broadcasts.

Government personnel and the general public may use this system to retrieve RTCM Messages. A User shall not: 1) knowingly and without authorization, alter, damage, or destroy the Arizona Spatial Reference Center's or another user's computer system, network, software, program, documentation or data contained therein; 2) use this service to conduct or attempt to conduct any business or activity or solicit the performance of any activity that is prohibited by law. In addition, taking action which results in blocking access to these IP addresses by other users will be deemed an unauthorized use and may subject the User to law enforcement action. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this agreement remain in full force, and effect.

A User shall not hold themselves out as a representative, agent, or employee of ADWR and ADWR shall not be liable for any representation, act or omission of the User.

This system uses administrative monitoring of Users accessing the system. System administrators may provide evidence of possible criminal activity identified during such monitoring to appropriate law enforcement officials. If you (User) do not wish to consent to monitoring, or any other terms of this agreement, do not accept this agreement.
